Anti Bullying survey for the pupils

We recently surveyed the 2nd - 6th class students on Anti Bullying and the following are some of the results:

- 95% felt safe and happy in the school
- 7% did not know what bullying behaviour was
- 9% said that people were being left out or ignored on purpose
- 25% said that there was malicious rumours or gossip online
- 88% felt that there was an adult in school that they could talk to about bullying
